Entercom License, LLC ("Entercom"), licensee of Station KDGS(FM), Andover, Kansas (Facility Id. No. 70266) (the "Station"), is today filing an application to make changes in the facilities of the Station (the "KDGS Application").

The KDGS Application, and an application being filed by Niemeyer Communications, LLC, licensee of Station KOTE(FM), Eureka, Kansas (Facility ID No. 48789) (the "KOTE Application"), are being submitted in response to the Commission's May 28, 2013 letter, ordering changes in frequency for the respective stations to accommodate an application filed by Community Broadcasting, Inc. to operate Station KCVW(FM), Kingman, Kansas, on Channel 232C1 (FCC File No. BPED-20111214ABT, granted May 28, 2013) (the "KCVW Application"). Because the KDGS Application and the KOTE Application involve interrelated frequency changes, it is requested that they be processed concurrently.

In conjunction with the filing of the KDGS Application, Entercom withdraws its Petition for Reconsideration of the grant of the KCVW Application, filed June 27, 2013.
