Dear Counsel:

This is in reference to the request filed May 2, 2014, on behalf of Saga Communications of New England, Inc. ("Saga").<sup>1</sup> Saga explains that it received an interference complaint while operating with the parameters authorized by STA BSTA-20140310ADG (changed directional pattern). Saga is reviewing the complaint, and in the meantime is requesting an STA to operate with those STA same facilities with reduced ERP values, up to a maximum of 0.100 kW.

Unlike regular FM broadcast stations, FM translarors are required to submit a construction permit application for any change in antenna. *See* 47 CFR Sections 74.1251(a) and (b). Saga's modified directional pattern will not result in the extension of the 60 dBu service contour beyond the currently licensed 60 dBu contour.

An STA will enable the licensee to address the interference complaint while maintaining service. Accordingly, an STA for operation with the requested directional pattern, at effective radiated powers up to a maximum of 0.100 kW, IS GRANTED for a period of 180 days. This STA is conditioned on Saga filing a construction permit application on FCC Form 349 within 45 days of the date of this letter.<sup>2</sup> Additionally, Saga is responsible for addressing interference complaints that may arise from this STA operation. Saga must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from radiofrequency exposure in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.
