Dear Counsel:

This is in reference to the request filed April 28, 2014, on behalf of Ovid-Elsie Area Schools ("OEAS"). OEAS requests an extension of the Special Temporary Authority (STA) granted January 30, 2014 for WOES' continued operation with reduced power. OEAS has ordered a replacement antenna and anticipates that full power operation will resume within the next several weeks.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

We find that extension of STA is warranted, and the extension IS HEREBY GRANTED. WOES may continue to operate at reduced power. OEAS must notify the Commission when licensed operation is restored. OEAS must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from radiofrequency exposure in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR §1.1310.

This authority expires on November 4, 2014.
