> > Request for Extension of Special Temporary Authority to Remain Silent

Dear Mr. Urick:

This letter concerns the request you filed on January 27, 2014, on behalf of Media Institute for Social Change ("MISC"), for extension of Special Temporary Authority to permit FM Translator Station K219KU to remain silent.

Commission records reflect that MISC stated that Station K219KU went silent on July 15, 2013, for technical reasons. The previous STA was granted on September 18, 2013, and expired on March 17, 2014. MISC requests extension of its STA for continuing technical reasons. The request includes the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.

MISC's request is granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station K219KU to remain silent until July 15, 2014. Notwithstanding the grant of this Special Temporary Authority, the broadcast license for Station K219KU will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not commence by 12:01 a.m., July 16, 2014.¹ See Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. § 312(g).

The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. It is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed. *See* 47 C.F.R. §§ 17.6 and 73.1740(a)(4).
