Dear Mr. Naftalin:

This letter refers to the above-captioned application filed by CBI for a new AM station at Lemon Grove, California; our January 10, 2011, letter requesting an amendment to address the daytime coverage issue; and the February 9, 2011, amendment.

A preliminary review of the amended application reveals that CBI requested that the Commission withhold action on the application to allow CBI additional time to discuss with the licensee of the Mexican stations XEPF and XEXX to adjust their patterns so that CBI can amend the application to meet the 100% coverage requirement. As of today's date we have not received any such amendment.

Further action on the application will be withheld for a period of thirty (30) days from the date of this letter to file a curative amendment. Failure to amend or respond with a formal written request for a specific amount of time to amend within this time period will result in the dismissal of the application pursuant to Section 73.3568 of the Commission's rules.
