This letter is to inform you that on May 16th, 2014, WVEP-FM (Facility ID: 70643) owned by West Virginia Educational Broadcasting Authority (WVEBA) went silent due to high winds which caused the transmission line to physically detach from the antenna. The detached transmission line suffered irreparable mechanical damage and must be replaced. WVEBA has acquired a new transmission line and is now waiting for its delivery and installation. It is believed that the repair of the facility will fall within a 10 to 30 day window from the date of going silent. The anticipated date of going back on-the-air is May 27, 2014

In the event that the facility cannot be repaired within 30 days from May 16th 2014, then a silent STA shall be filed pursuant to Section 73.1635 of the FCC rules.
