Request for Special Temporary Authority to Remain Silent

Dear Mr. Lanke:

This letter concerns the request you filed on March 27, 2014, on behalf of WMHD-FM ("WMHD-FM"), for Special Temporary Authority to permit FM Radio Station WMHD to remain silent.

WMHD-FM's request states that Station WMHD(FM) went silent on September 30, 2013, for staffing reasons. The request includes the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.¹

WMHD-FM's request is granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station WMHD(FM) to remain silent until September 30, 2014. Notwithstanding the grant of this Special Temporary Authority, the broadcast license for Station WMHD(FM) will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not commence by 12:01 a.m., October 1, 2014.² See Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. § 312(g).

The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. It is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed. *See* 47 C.F.R. §§ 17.6 and 73.1740(a)(4).

Finally, Section 73.1740(a)(4) of the Commission's Rules permits licensees to temporarily discontinue operations for good cause, and for a period not to exceed 30 days without further authority. *See* 47 C.F.R. § 73.1740(a)(4). This rule requires that the licensee notify the Commission by letter not later than the 10th day of limited or discontinued operations, and requires a licensee to seek Commission authorization for any period of limited or discontinued operations exceeding 30 days. WMHD-FM failed

to submit a timely request for an STA to permit Station WMHD(FM) to remain silent beyond October 30, 2013, and the action taken herein shall not be construed as authorizing the station to remain silent between October 30, 2013, and March 27, 2014.
