Dear Mr. Fuller:

This is in reference to the above-captioned application to relocate the transmitter site and construct a taller antenna for station KVTk(AM).

A preliminary engineering study of the application reveals that a tower sketch of the proposed antenna is not provided. In addition, in the engineering statement you do not define the extent the ground system will be shortened by the site boundaries and its effect on the radiation. Finally, the proposed ground system plat in Exhibit E-16 shows at different coordinates and includes an additional element which needs an explanation as to it will be used or detuned.

Further action on the subject application will be withheld for thirty (30) days from the date of this letter in order to provide 5-Star Communications Inc. an opportunity to file a curative amendment. The amendment must be submitted in the same manner as the original application and must be a minor change with respect to the previously filed technical submission.
