Letter Request pursuant to 73.1560(d)

Chester County Radio, Incorporated, Licensee of WCHE(AM), 1520 KHz, West Chester, PA (Fac. ID 71279) files this Letter Notification pursuant to 73.1560(d), Request for 30 day authority to operate with technical parameters at variance with the terms and conditions of current License, File Number BL-20090625ACZ.

As a result of severe weather, WCHE(AM) is unable to maintain operating power within the limits of 73.1560(a) and is currently operating at 75% of authorized power. Problem is due to a failure in one of the four combined power amplifiers in the transmitter. Parts to complete repairs are on order and the transmitter will be restored to normal operation as soon as the undersigned returns from a technical conference followed by a short vacation in New England. Since the total period until repairs can be completed will exceed 10 days as required by 73.1560(d), we therefore request authority for 30 days to complete transmitter repairs.

During this period, we will continue to comply with Monitoring Point limits as spelled out in BL-20090625ACZ.
