This letter, filed in triplicate on behalf of Cumulus Licensing LLC ("Cumulus"), the licensee of Station WVNN(AM), notifies the Federal Communications Commission that the Station's nighttime operation was interrupted when a severe storm blew down the studio-transmitter link receive antenna. Cumulus' local engineers are working diligently to resolve this problem and hope to restore nighttime service within several weeks. This occurrence had no impact on the daytime operation of WVNN.

Cumulus will submit a formal request for Special Temporary Authority if this technical problem is not fixed within thirty (30) days.
