This is in reference to the request filed February 13, 2006, on behalf of Entercom New Orleans License, LLC ("Entercom"). Entercom requests modification of the special temporary authority ("STA") granted on October 28, 2005, to operate Station WTKL (formerly WKBU) with emergency antenna facilities pursuant to Section 73.1680.

In support of the request, Entercom states that the station's licensed facilities were destroyed by Hurricane Katrina on August 29, 2005, and that the station has restored operations from the auxiliary antenna of nearby, commonly owned Station WLMG(FM). Entercom seeks modification of STA to increase the effective radiated power to 5 kilowatts.

Our review indicates that the proposed, modified emergency antenna operation would continue to comply with Section 73.1680 and our STA policies.

Accordingly, the request for modification of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station WTKL may operate with the following facilities:

Entercom must notify the Commission when licensed operation is restored. Entercom must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on August 23, 2006.
