Dear Mr. Young:

On June 12, 2014, we sent you a letter notifying you that our records showed that Station WFWO(FM) ("Station") was off the air. At that time, we gave you 30 days to submit documented proof of the Station's operation since August 21, 2012, noting that failure to respond "will result in adverse actions jeopardizing both the station's license and call letters." As of the date of this letter, we have received no response.

Accordingly, the Commission's public and internal databases have been modified to indicate that the broadcast license for the referenced station IS EXPIRED, that the Station's license IS CANCELED as a matter of law, and that the station's call sign IS DELETED. The Station's pending application for renewal (File No. BRED-20140203ATO) IS DISMISSED.

Finally, we note that it is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower be maintained until the tower is dismantled. Accordingly, the owner of the tower where the referenced station's transmitting antenna is located is required to maintain the tower in the manner prescribed by our rules and the terms of the cancelled license.¹
