Dear Counsel:

This is in reference to the request filed May 6, 2014 on behalf of WZOE, Inc. ("WZOE"). WZOE requested Special Temporary Authority to operate with an emergency antenna at an alternate site following "unrepairable tower damage." But by letter dated August 19, 2014, WZOE advised that the antenna structure had been replaced and that WRVY-FM had resumed operations from its authorized transmitter site on August 15, 2014. The letter also advised that the station was operating at about 33% of licensed power because of a failed transmitter, and that an STA for reduced power operation would be requested if the issue could not be rectified within 30 days.

Accordingly, we conclude that there is no longer any need for WZOE to continue operating with the requested emergency antenna, and the present STA request IS DISMISSED.
