

Dear Mr. Jazzo:

This is in reference to the request filed on August 7, 2014. PMA requests further extension of the STA granted on July 28, 2010, to operate with increased nighttime power to overcome interference from the unauthorized non-directional operation of station CMBD, La Habana, Cuba. In support of the request, PMA provided measurements to verify that the interference continues.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station WTLN may continue to operate during nighttime hours with increased nominal power not to exceed 10 kilowatts. It will be necessary to reduce power or cease STA operation if complaints of interference are received. PMA must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310. This authority will terminate automatically upon cessation of the unregistered operation by the CMBD, otherwise this authority expires on **March 5, 2015**.
