On behalf of Navajo Ministries, Inc., licensee of noncommercial educational radio Station KNMI(FM), Farmington, New Mexico, we hereby inform the Commission that KNMI has resumed full power, licensed operation following a period of reduced power operation.

The licensee previously notified the Commission in FCC File No. BSTA-20140602BAU of KNMI's temporary reduced power status due to equipment problems, and requested Special Temporary Authority for the reduced power operation to continue for more than 30 days.
