Dear Mr. Jacobs:

This is in reference to the request filed on August 25, 2014. RVCM requests a seventh extension of the STA granted on November 2, 2009, to operate Station WVZN with temporary facilities due to loss of the licensed site in 2007. In support of the request, we noted that RVCM filed an FCC Form 301 application (BP-20140425AAA) which remains pending before the Commission.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station WVZN may continue to operate with the following facilities:

It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. RVCM must notify the Commission when licensed operation is restored. RVCM must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR § 1.1310.
