Dear Applicant:

This refers to your attorney's letter dated September 18, 2014, for special temporary authority (STA) to operate at reduced effective radiated power (ERP). You indicate that WBTV-TV is currently operating at 50% of authorized power due to the unexpected failure of one of the station's inductive output tubes. You state that reduced power operations will continue to be necessary while the applicant is trying to complete the work and restore full power operation.

In light of the above, special temporary authority pursuant to Sections 73.1560(d) and 73.1635 of the Commission's Rules until March 22, 2015 IS GRANTED.

We wish to point out that an extension of this request must include detailed reasons and a description of efforts being taken to return the station to full power operation.
