The Video Division issued an Order to Show Cause on March 29, 2012 calling upon Digital TV of Orlando, LLC ("Licensee") to show cause why its authorization for Class A television station WHDO-CA (the "Station") should not be modified to specify the Station as a low power television station.<sup>1</sup> Based upon the unique factual circumstances involving the Licensee and Station, we hereby rescind the Order to Show Cause.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that the Order to Show Cause issued to Digital TV of Orlando, LLC is hereby RESCINDED.
