PETITION TO DENY

To: Chief, Video Division, Media Bureau

Michael Couzens (Petitioner) here petitions to deny the assignment of the station listed, together with ten other stations, to Hispanic Family Christian Network, Inc.¹ This petition is filed pursuant to Section 309(d) of the Communications Act, 47 U.SC. Sec, 309(d) and Section 1.939 or 73.3584(b) of the Commission's Rules and Regulations.

The petition is based on probative evidence that the assignor, Hispanic Christian Community Network, Inc. (HCCN), is not in compliance with Section 310 of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. Sec. 310, relating to interests of aliens and foreign governments. That being the case, there is no valid ownership interest to assign.

The petition is further based on probative evidence that the assignment is a sham transaction, including evidence (a) that the proposed assignment Hispanic Family Community Network, Inc. ("HFCN") is a long dormant and now defunct Texas corporation; (b) and that whatever else it is, HFCN is a sham entity that will remain under the complete dominance and control of the assignor.

I represent plaintiffs in a law suit in Los Angeles County Superior Court against HCCN, its 100 per cent record owner Antonio Cesar Guel, Roberto Gomez, and Iglesia Jesucristo Es Mi Refugio, Inc. ("IGMR"): Jose Gonzalez et al.v. Iglesia Jesucristo Es Mi Refugio, Inc. et al, No. BC 501688. The Verified Second Amended Complaint was filed on March 14, 2014. It alleges that plaintiffs, including

four pastors and a business person, together with one other pastor, were persuaded to pay and did pay to defendants \$1,299,090.00 in purchase money to acquire ownership of two low power television broadcast stations, K43AG and KSSY-LP. The stations were licensed initially to HCCN, and later to IGMR. Buyers were assured that Guel would capably move them from rural parts of California where they were situated and licensed to the commanding Los Angeles overlook site at Mount Wilson. No assignment applications were ever filed, the stations were not moved to Mount Wilson, and none of the money has been returned. The complaint alleges breach of contract and fraud.

A. ASSIGNOR HAS NOTHING TO ASSIGN BECAUSE THE SOLE OWNER IS NOT A UNITED STATES CITIZEN.

The Act, Section 310(b), provides that "No broadcast . . . license shall be granted to or held by (3) any corporation of which more than one-fifth of the capital stock is owned of record or voted by aliens or their representatives. . . ." The most recent ownership report for HCCN, File No. BOA-20131220HCO, states that 100% of votes and 100% of equity in HCCN are held by one individual, Antonio Cesar Guel ("Guel"). The report states his citizenship as "US." However, the statement is false. There is no record of any assignment or transfer that would render the ownership today any different from that disclosed in the most recent ownership report.

In discovery for the law suit, form interrogatories and specially prepared interrogatories were served on defendants. Guel objected to and failed to answer questions regarding his citizenship. Plaintiffs brought a motion to compel further answer, granted by the judge in an order issued on May 14, 2014. Guel was ordered to serve written verified responses without objection within 10 days of the ruling. In light of that ruling Guel served a supplemental response on May 19, <u>Attachment A</u>, which states as follows:

Supplemental Response to Special Interrogatory No. 10:

I am not a natural born United States citizen.

Supplemental Response to Special Interrogatory No. 11

I have not yet become a naturalized United States citizen.

Supplemental Response to Special Interrogatory No. 12

I am not a United States citizen at this time.

His certification stated:

I declare under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of California that the foregoing to

true and correct. Executed on May 19, 2014, at Dallas, Texas. /s/ Antonio Cesar Guel.

Guel's statement is admissible evidence, information "of which official notice may be taken," 47 U.S.C. Sec. 309(d), because it constitutes an admission under the Federal Rules of Evidence, not subject to the hearsay objection.² In every case, the stations proposed for assignment were acquired through a false representation of United States citizenship, and all such grants of license are void or voidable. Under long-standing policy formulated by the Commission and upheld by the courts, radio station licensees whose renewal applications have been designated for hearing on basic qualification issues — as the present applications must be prior to any grant — are forbidden to transfer control of the licenses, *Jefferson Radio Co. v. FCC*, 340 F.2d 781, 783 (D.C. Cir, 1964, see *Northland Television*, 42 R.R.2d 1107 (1978).

B. THE PROPOSED ASSIGNEE DOES NOT LEGALLY EXIST AND IS A SHAM ENTITY.

According to the application, Exhibit 4, "No written agreement. Corporate reorganization to another corporation. No consideration is being paid in conjunction with this assignment." Supposedly, the assignee HFCN is "a not-for-profit corporation." Section III, Question 4. How and with what tax consequences numerous licensees may be transferred from a for-profit entity to a non-profit entity is never explained. In any event, assignee HFCN is not a corporation of any kind because its Texas charter was revoked through a tax forfeiture on February 10, 2012, <u>Attachment B</u>. It has been non-existent for more than two and a half years.

HFCN was incorporated in October, 2007, in Texas, with Guel as incorporator (Article 8) and as one of four directors (Article 7), Attachment C. In 2008 he became the registered agent, in a filing he signed as President, Attachment D. In February, 2010, a new board was reported to the State (Attachment E), with three members, including as President Maria C. Guel, 2605 Hyacinth Dr., Mesquite, TX 75181. That was the residential address at which our process server located Guel and served him. On information and belief, Maria is Mr. Guel's spouse. The board remained the same when the entity was suspended in 2012, and then on January 28, 2013, when a public information report, Attachment F, was filed. The signatory, humorously, is "Cesar Guel" with title: "Electronic."

The commingling of HCCN and HFCN is seen in the assignment of an FM translator, K218CU, Facility ID, 91155, File No. BALFT-20101103ADI, official notice requested. Seller is HFCN, using HCCN's long time business address at 8500 N Stemmons Fwy, Suite 5050, Dallas. The telephone

number is Mr. Guel's. The assignor portion is executed by Maria Cristina Guel, President. But the asset purchase, Exhibit 4, depicts the seller as HCCN, and is executed for seller by Antonio Cesar Guel, President, Attachment G. The licensee was HFCN but the sales proceeds were being paid to HCCN.³

By the time HFCN filed its first ownership report, BON-20130128AAZ, Guel apparently deemed it advisable to make his dominance and control less blatant. Now the residential addresses had disappeared. The same address was given for each of the three directors: 13155 Noel Road, Suite 900, Dallas, Texas, the address of the Galleria Dallas mega-mall. It is certain that none of the directors has a residence in that complex. One week after that ownership report was filed at the FCC, over the signature of Mrs. Guel, a public information report was filed for HCCN (Not HFCN) over the signature of Mr. Guel, truthfully listing the Hyacinth address for both, Attachment H. Mrs. Guel is listed as a director and secretary of HCCN, two reportable and highly material facts not disclosed to the Commission at the same time in the HFCN ownership report: Section II, Question 7, Maria Cristina Guel, "No Other Interests."

Petitioner has no need to speculate as to what inspired Guel to make the massive assignment of the entire HCCN portfolio free of charge, prompting this petition. Guel's alien ownership problem has begun to surface at the Commission, *see* my petition to deny the renewal of KJPO-LD, Parker, AZ, BRDTL-20140602AUI and others. Possibly Mrs. Guel and her two cohort former directors of the defunct HFCN are United States Citizens, so this was an attempt to side-step the issue. What does seem clear is that the transaction cannot be approved given the widespread indicia of non-disclosure, fraud and commingling of assets and concealed positional interests. Our case in Los Angeles Superior Court is set for a jury trial on March 26, 2015. Without doubt a central purpose of these sham assignments is to remove assets from named defendant HCCN. Such a layered and multiple fraud must not be permitted.⁴

A uniform feature of all transactions between HCCN and HFCN, and involving either of them with a third party, is the role of one attorney, Dan J. Alpert, as the contact representative. In the series of assignment applications discussed herein he is comfortably ensconced as the contact representative for assignor HCCN, Section I, Question 2, and of HFCN, Section III, Question 3. Obviously there is no conflict of interest because he is facilitating the sham transaction in behalf of both. On May 24,

Commission approval of this mess apparently gave the clear signal to Guel that he was free – in this and other matters – to act with complete impunity.

Mr. Guel, it is fair to say, is one of the most prolific creators of sham entities for FCC application purposes in the entire history of broadcasting, see for example, *Antonio Cesar Guel*, DA 14-670, released on May 16, 2014 (MB).

2014, I wrote a letter to Mr. Alpert. He signed a receipt for the letter on May 27. In the letter I noted that since 2009 Mr. Alpert had been making filings containing the false representation of Guel's citizenship. "I am writing to forward Mr. Guel's sworn admission as to lack of U.S. Citizenship. Should you choose to continue in making such FCC filings in the future, you will be doing so with provable actual knowledge of the falsity." The present mass assignment in part may be a response. But time will tell whether or not these applicants choose to maintain the facade of Section III, Question 6(b), certifying that there are not pending any broadcast applications in which character issues have been raised.

C. CONCLUSION

Petitioner does not claim nor seek status as a party. This filing is undertaken because HCCN should not be permitted to divest itself of assets in a sham transaction, while substantial and credible court claims are pending against it based on breach opf contract and fraud. The proposed assignments *en masse* of the HCCN broadcast portfolio should not be granted unless further inquiry is made to determine whether Mr. Guel's entity has acquired all such HCCN interests through the misrepresentation of his citizenship, and whether Mr. Guel and his spouse have created this sham transaction for improper reasons or through unlawful devices.



The undersigned natural person, a citizen of the State of Texas, over the age of eighteen (18) years, acting as the sole incorporator of a corporation under the Texas Non-Profit Corporation Act, does hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

ARTICLE ONE. The name of the corporation is:

HISPANIC FAMILY CHRISTIAN NETWORK, INC.

ARTICLE TWO. The corporation is a non-profit corporation.

ARTICLE THREE. The period of its duration is perpetual.

ARTICLE FOUR. The purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable activities that qualify as exempt activities under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal revenue law) and Texas Tax Code Section 11.18 (c).

The primary purpose of the corporation is: To open a Christian Radio Station to help our Hispanic community, and promote social welfare by broadcasting conferences and workshops, providing research and publishing materials on social, literary and political topics related to U. S. affairs.

The corporation shall have and exercise all rights and powers conferred on non-profit corporations under the Texas Non-Profit Corporation Act; provided, however, that this corporation under the Texas Non-Profit Corporation Act; provided, however, that this corporation shall not, except to to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the primary purpose of this corporation or which are not permitted by Section 201 (c) (4) of the Internal Revenue Code.

This corporation is organized pursuant to the Texas Non-Profit Corporation Act and does not contemplate pecuniary gain or profit to any person and is organized solely for non-profit purposes.

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of any Director of the corporation, officer of the corporation, or any private individual (except that reasonable compensation may be paid for services rendered to or for corporation affecting one or more of its purposes), and no Director of officer of the corporation, or any private

individual shall be entitled to share in the distribution of any of the corporate assets on dissolution of the corporation. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publication or distribution of statements) any political campaign, on behalf of any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles of Incorporation, the corporation shall not conduct or carry on any activities not permitted to be conducted or carried no by an organization exempt from taxation under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code and its Regulations as they now exist or as they may hereafter be amended, or by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal revenue Code and Regulations as they now exist or as they may hereafter be amended.

Upon dissolution of the corporation or the winding up of its affairs, assets of the corporation shall be distributed exclusively to civic leagues or organizations not organized for profit but operated exclusively for the promotion of social welfare which would then qualify under the provisions of section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code and its Regulations as they now exist or as they may hereafter be amended.

ARTICLE FIVE. The corporation shall have no members.
