Dear Madam Secretary:

In creating a new class of low power FM stations, Congress sought to provide for community radio stations in urban areas. Despite their restrictions, these low power stations provide some measure of ownership for new entrants, non-profits, minorities and others who are under-represented in broadcast ownership and who have been encouraged to apply for the stations. Emperor's Circle of Shen Yun applauds the Commission and the Bureau for its efforts and the ongoing proceeding.

The window for applications closed in November 2013 and the Commission has announced that 2500 plus applications were filed. We welcomed the window of opportunity given to applicants in mutually exclusive situations to attempt to resolve mutual exclusivity. To secure expedited processing of any settlement agreement, any such agreements are required to be filed by today.

In the Los Angeles County Basis, significant and novel problems exist. No other market has 30 plus an application for a single channel and no other market has such immense and widely distributed diversity in need of broadcast service. This justifies the Commission using its discretion to address processing timelines.
