
The staff has under consideration the above-captioned application for a modification to a construction permit.

An engineering study has revealed a discrepancy with the tower height above ground level proposed in the application compared to that on the tower registration record. The application indicates a tower HAGL of 75 meters. However, the tower registration record (#1017972) specifies a tower HAGL of 81.10 meters. This discrepancy must be eliminated. Therefore, if the tower HAGL is 75 meters, the applicant must amend the tower registration record. If the tower HAGL is 81.10 meters, the applicant must amend all pertinent parts of the application to indicate the correct tower height above ground level.

In addition, an engineering study has revealed a discrepancy with the site elevation above mean sea level ("SEAMSL") proposed in the application compared to that on the tower registration record. The application indicates a SEAMSL of 159 meters. However, the tower registration record (#1017972) specifies a SEAMSL of 156.7 meters. This discrepancy must be eliminated. Therefore, if the SEAMSL is 159 meters, the applicant must amend the tower registration record. If the SEAMSL is 156.7 meters, the applicant must amend all pertinent parts of the application to indicate the correct site elevation above mean sea level.

Further action on the subject application will be withheld for a period of thirty days from the date of this letter to provide WPVC an opportunity to respond. Failure to respond within this time period will result in the dismissal of the application pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 73.3568(a). Please note that any amendment must be submitted in the same manner as the original application.
