Dear Applicant:

This refers to your attorney's letter dated August 28, 2014, for special temporary authority (STA) to operate at reduced effective radiated power (ERP). You indicate that shortly following the completion of the build out of the facilities set forth in the authorized construction permit, the station suffered a power surge of its main transmitter, rendering that transmitter IOT tube useless. You state that reduced power operations will continue to be necessary while the applicant is trying to replace the equipment and restore full power operation.

In light of the above, special temporary authority pursuant to Sections 73.1560(d) and 73.1635 of the Commission's Rules until May 24, 2015 IS GRANTED.

We wish to point out that an extension of this request must include detailed reasons and a description of efforts being taken to return the station to full power operation.
