
Dear Mr. Jacobs:

This letter is in reference to the above-captioned minor change application filed by RVCM to change site, reduce tower height, and increase efficiency using a Valcom antenna.

A preliminary review of the application reveals that the local approval and NEPA process had not yet been completed, and that a final amendment would be filed to certify "YES" to question #11 on FCC Form 301 to verify the application was found to be acceptable from an environmental viewpoint.

Further action on the subject application will be withheld for a period of 180 days from the date of this letter in order to allow time to file the required curative amendment. Failure to amend within this time period will result in the dismissal of the application pursuant to Section 73.3568 of the Commission's rules.
