Dear Mr. Lipp:

This is in reference to the request filed on October 27, 2014. RLH requests a second extension of the STA granted on November 27, 2013, to operate AM station KTCK(AM) with reduced power during daytime hours due to equipment problems. In support of the request, RLH states that a method of moment proof will be completed and filed in an FCC Form 302 application in order to return to licensed operations.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station KTCK(AM) may continue to operate during daytime hours with a reduced power of 15 kW. It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received.

¹ KTCK(AM) is licensed for DA operation on 1310 kHz with 25 kW daytime and 5 kW night.

RLH must notify the Commission when licensed operation is restored.² RLH must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310. We anticipate that RLH will file an FCC Form 302 application before the expiration date shown below.

This authority expires on May 24, 2015.
