RE: Broadcast licenses granted by the Federal Communications Commission to serve the public interest as a public trustee until August 1, 2014 for FM radio stations WRTI, WRTX, WJAZ, WRTL, WRTY and WRTJ and their request for renewal of their licenses

Gentlemen:

I am writing as a resident of the Hazleton area Pennsylvania community, encompassed by the Hazleton Area School District and the Weatherly Area School District, in northeastern Pennsylvania, to request that WRTI, the main FM radio station in this matter and where all programming originates for the other abovementioned stations which are satellite stations, extend its broadcasting range to cover the Hazleton area community, a community in excess of 72,000 people, as a condition of renewal of their broadcast licenses by the Federal Communications Commission.

The WRTI network has satellite radio stations not only as indicated above but also in Pottsville, Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania, Wilkes-Barre, northern Luzerne County, Pennsylvania and Jackson Township, Monroe County, Pennsylvania, respectively to the south, the north and east of the Hazleton area community which receives, at best, only sporadically poor or no reception of those radio signals or any other reception of WRTI radio signals.


I question why this is so and why the Hazleton area Pennsylvania community has been excluded from WRTI program broadcasting, being virtually surrounded by these other WRTI satellite radio stations serving only those communities surrounding the Hazleton area community and not the Hazleton area community which is merits such service.

Specifically, I am requesting that WRTI radio reception be established in and for the Hazleton area community, equal to what has been done for all the surrounding communities, in order to serve equally the public interest of the Hazleton area community which is not being served by WRTI's excellent programming and that such service for the Hazleton area community be made a condition for the renewal of the licenses of the above referenced radio stations.
