Finding of No Significant Impact

Dear Mr. Kelly:

This letter concerns the referenced application of Divine Mercy Communications, Inc. (“Divine Mercy”), as amended, for minor modification of the facilities of Station WDMC(AM), Melbourne, Florida (the “Station”) which proposes to change the Station’s antenna site and technical facilities. In the amended application, Divine Mercy proposes to construct three new 60.7-meter (199-foot) towers (with concomitant ground-level equipment) at the proposed site from which Divine Mercy will operate both daytime and nighttime facilities for WDMC(AM). Because the proposed transmitter location is located in a flood plain, Divine Mercy submitted an Environmental Assessment (“EA”) as required by Section 1.1307 of the Commission’s Rules (the “Rules”)¹ on August 28, 2014. *Public Notice* of the filing of the EA was issued on November 13, 2014.² The Commission received no comments in response to the *Notice*.

Upon examination of the EA, we find that the information supplied satisfies the requirements specified in Section 1.1311 of the Rules.³ Accordingly, pursuant to Section 1.1308 of the Rules,⁴ we find that the WDMC(AM) towers will have no significant environmental impact on the quality of the human environment, and no further environmental processing is warranted. Moreover, we have examined the captioned application and find that it complies with all pertinent statutory and regulatory requirements. Accordingly, the application (File No. BP-20140311ADU) of Divine Mercy Communications, Inc. for modification of the facilities of Station WDMC(AM), Melbourne, Florida, IS GRANTED.
