Dear Applicant:

On March 2, 2006, the applicant as addressed above was sent a letter outlining the following interference problem and the excessive distance between proposed and existing coordinates issue. The applicant was given the opportunity to file a minor amendment to resolve these specified issues within 30 days from the date of that letter. If not so amended, the application will be considered incomplete and subsequently dismissed.

Specifically, the proposal is predicted to cause interference to the following facilities:

1. K49IB, Estes Park, CO. – BMPTTL-20040521AHW.

In addition to the above interference issue, our analysis revealed the following issue:

2. The proposed coordinates are a distance of 57.753 kilometers (35.886 miles) from the current license coordinates. Justification for the distance is required.

Our records show that no amendment has been filed to resolve the interference and distance issues; therefore, the above-referenced application is considered incomplete and IS HEREBY DISMISSED.
