Greetings:

I am the individual owner of Isleta Radio Company, the licensee of AM station KQNM.

This letter is with reference to the e-mail to me from Joseph Sczcesny dated Friday, October 17, 2014 in which an amendment was requested for my application for minor change for AM station KQNM (BP-20140715ABR).

My technical consultant, Don Davis, has finished preparing most of the amendment. He has been working with the tower owner, SBA Towers, to secure a plat of the property, which he now has received. Mr. Davis was planning to finish the amendment for filing this week, but suffered a hernia for which he has scheduled surgery tomorrow, Friday November 14<sup>th</sup>. Mr. Davis plans to return to work next week, and has assured me the amendment will be filed as soon as he has the opportunity to verify his work through an inspection of the tower site.

The 30-day period for filing the amendment runs through this Sunday, November 16<sup>th</sup>, therefore I am respectfully requesting an additional 30-day period during which the amendment to the KQNM application may be filed. I expect the amendment will be filed much earlier; I am requesting the 30-day period in an "abundance of caution".
