Special Temporary Authorization

Dear Applicant:

This is in reference to the request for Special Temporary Authority dated November 24, 2009, filed on behalf of Bott Communications, Inc. ("Bott"), licensee of Station WCRT(AM), Donelson, Tennessee. Bott requests an extension of an existing special temporary authority ("STA") to operate an FM booster to rebroadcast Station WCRT(AM) to overcome interference from foreign stations. WCRT-FM1 has been operating per Special Temporary Authority since August 14, 1990.

In support of its request, Bott states that the requested STA is needed to combat the objectionable interference currently being caused by the co-channel operation of a Cuban station within its interference-free nighttime signal.

In light of the above, the Special Temporary Authority IS HEREBY GRANTED for Bott to operate an FM repeater to rebroadcast WCRT(AM), during nighttime hours, with the facilities as follows:

It will be necessary to reduce power or cease STA operation if complaints of interference are received. Bott must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to Bott frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310. This STA will be canceled once one of the mutual exclusive applications (BNPFT-20030317MTJ, BNPFT-20030311AGB, BNPFT-20030317LUF or BNPFT-20030310AXC) file a license application and commence operations.

Unless terminated earlier, this authority expires on February 25, 2011.
