Subject: “Informal Objection” To License Renewal

I’m writing this letter to file an Informal Objection to the license renewal for the following radio Station:

KFBK (1530AM) Sacramento, CA #10145

I do not feel this station is fulfilling its obligation to serve the public interest”, an explicit requirement (and public expectation) for continued licensing.

KFBK’s failure to serve the public interest stems from their line-up of politically biased, syndicated talk show programs - virtually all day and evening. This program line-up amounts to their use of the airwaves as a political “pulpit”, presenting only one-sided, predictable opinion – and even endorsing and promoting one political party and individual candidates. Their failure to present objective information is not serving the public interest and could even be called a dis-service to the democratic process – especially near election time.

Any renewal of this station’s FCC license should only be with the condition that they better serve the “public interest” by offering some programs in their line-up that provide alternative political viewpoints.
