On behalf of Newark Public Radio, Inc., licensee of noncommercial educational digital radio station WBGO(FM), Newark, New Jersey, we respectfully request a sixty (60) day extension of time, up to and including April 16, 2015, to amend the above-referenced auxiliary antenna construction permit application in FCC File No. BXPED-20111213ABU.

This request is provided in response to an FCC letter dated January 15, 2015 (copy enclosed). By that letter, the Media Bureau informed Newark Public Radio that further action on the auxiliary permit application would be withheld until such time as the applicant could provide requested information concerning Federal Aviation Administration approval and FCC registration of the proposed auxiliary facility site's antenna structure.

Newark Public Radio's engineering consultant filed the requisite application with the Federal Aviation Administration on February 11, 2015 in FAA Aeronautical Study Number 2015-AEA-735-OE (see enclosed), and the filing is currently under review by the FAA. Following an FAA determination, Newark Public Radio will also address the FCC Antenna Structure Registration process and then amend its auxiliary antenna permit application. Accordingly, while the antenna structure filing and registration process continues, Newark Public Radio respectfully requests an additional 60 days as needed to accommodate the completion of the process, and to allow for the requested amendment of the application.
