Dear Licensee:

This is with respect to station the above referenced stations. Section 312(g) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended,¹ provides that:

If a broadcasting station fails to transmit broadcast signals for any consecutive 12-month period, then the station license granted for the operation of that broadcast station expires at the end of that period, notwithstanding any provision, term or condition of the license to the contrary . . .

Commission records indicate that WGMU-LP and W19BR has been silent since November 18, 2013 and that WBVT-LP has been silent since November 22, 2013. Accordingly, the licenses for WGMU-LP, W19BR and WBVT-LP ARE HEREBY CANCELLED, the call signs ARE DELETED, and any construction permits to these stations ARE CANCELLED. In addition, any STA requests ARE HEREBY DISMISSED.
