> > Request for Extension of Special Temporary Authority to Remain Silent

Dear Mr. Persh:

This letter concerns the request you filed on December 30, 2014, on behalf of the University of Wyoming ("University"), for extension of Special Temporary Authority to permit FM Translator Radio Station K210AF to remain silent.

University's request states that Station K210AF went silent on March 27, 2014, for technical reasons. The request includes the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.

University's request is granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station K210AF to remain silent not to exceed 180 days from the date of this letter. Notwithstanding the grant of this Special Temporary Authority, the broadcast license for Station K210AF will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not commence by 12:01 a.m., March 28, 2015.¹

University is required to notify the Commission when broadcast operations resume. If University does not file the notification of resumption of operations in a timely manner, the license may be subject to cancellation pursuant to Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, as amended.²

The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. Finally, we note that it is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed

painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed. See 47 C.F.R. §§ 17.6 and 73.1740(a)(4).
