Dear Ms. Dortch:

White Earth Land Recovery Project, the licensee of KKWE(FM), White Earth, Minnesota, FCC Facility ID No. 174165 (the "Station"), previously informed the Commission that, on or about October 25, 2014, an inspection of the Station disclosed damage to the transmitting facility, most likely from a lighting strike, and that the Station was operating at approximately 20% of the authorized transmitter power output, with reduced power operation expected to continue until the necessary repairs were completed. See FCC File No. BSTA-20141118ANO (granted November 24, 2014).

This letter is to inform the Commission that the Station resumed full power operations on March 11, 2015, following the replacement of the Station's directional antenna with an antenna of the same make and model and using the existing antenna mounts, so that the height and orientation of the antenna are unchanged. Under these circumstances, it is the licensee's understanding that a Form 302 is not required pursuant to Section 73.1690 of the Commission's rules.
