Gentlemen:

This refers to your attorney's letter dated April 3, 2015 requesting special temporary authority to operate at reduced effective radiated power (ERP). You indicate that the Electronics Research INC (ERI)'s pattern for the installed new antenna, slightly exceeds in some directions the pattern specified in the authorized construction permit. You state that reduced power operations will continue to be necessary while the applicant is in contact with ERI about the pattern data, trying to resolve the issue and restore full power operation.

In light of the above, special temporary authority pursuant to Sections 73.1560(d) and 73.1635 of the Commission's Rules until October 7, 2015 IS GRANTED.

We wish to point out that an extension of this request must include detailed reasons and a description of efforts being taken to return the station to full power operation.
