Dear Applicant:

We have received your amendment to the above proposal which was filed to resolve the interference deficiency as outlined below:

The proposal is predicted to cause interference to the following facilities:

1. K17LD-D – Fayetteville, AR. – BNPDTL-20100728ACL at 9.4%

The interference agreement with the licensee of K17LD-D is not valid since the licensee of K17LD-D is expecting a potential 7.5% interference from your proposed facility.

Shown below for your reference is the imported first paragraph from the interference agreement:

“Gameday Entertainment, LLC, the licensee of K17LD-D (Facility ID 187770) in Fayetteville, AR agrees to accept the potential 7.5% interference caused to the station by an application for modification filed by KAJL-LD”

If you do not amend your application electronically within 30 days from the date of this letter to resolve the above deficiency, we will dismiss your application.

Our engineering analysis taking in to account the amended specification shows that the above interference was not resolved by the amendment. The interference to the above referenced station actually increased to 10.1%; therefore, the above referenced application is hereby dismissed.
