Dear Mr. Groppe:

This is in reference to the request filed on April 17, 2015. DMC requests a fourth extension of the STA granted on March 12, 2013, to operate station WDMC(AM) with emergency antenna facilities pursuant to 73.1680 due the proposed site change.¹ In support of the request, DMC indicated that additional STA operation is needed at the old site until after a fully completed FCC Form 302 application has been filed and reviewed, and PTA granted at the new site.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:


- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

¹ WDMC(AM) is licensed for DA operation on 920 kHz with 5 kW day and 1 kW night, and the granted construction permit (BP-20140311ADU) authorizes a change in site and patterns.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station WDMC(AM) may continue to operate with an emergency ND antenna and reduced power not to exceed 1.25 kW day and 0.25 kW night at the currently licensed site. It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. DMC must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310. DMC will need to electronically file a new technical STA request (not an extension) if operation at the new site is desired per Section 73.1615 after all construction has been completed and while testing is underway (before PTA is authorized).

This authority expires on **November 13, 2015**.
