> Request for Extension of Special Temporary Authority to Remain Silent

Dear Mr. Martin:

This letter concerns the request you filed on May 19, 2015, on behalf of Living Proof, Inc. ("LP"), for extension of Special Temporary Authority ("STA") to permit FM Translator Station K270AK to remain silent.

Commission records reflect that LP stated that Station K270AK went silent on September 27, 2014, for technical reasons. The previous STA was granted on November 19, 2014, and expired on May 18, 2015. LP requests extension of its STA for continuing technical reasons. The request includes the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.

LP's request is granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station K270AK to remain silent until September 27, 2015. Notwithstanding the grant of this Special Temporary Authority, the broadcast license for Station K270AK will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not resume by 12:01 a.m., September 28, 2015.<sup>1</sup>

LP is required to notify the Commission when broadcast operations resume. If LP does not file the notification of resumption of operations in a timely manner, the license may be subject to cancellation pursuant to Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, as amended.<sup>2</sup>

The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. It is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed.<sup>3</sup>
