Dear Mr. Dickey:

This is in reference to the request filed on May 21, 2015. RLH requests a third extension of the STA granted on November 27, 2013, to operate AM station KTCK(AM) with reduced power during daytime hours due to equipment problems.¹ In support of the request, RLH states that in the past six month STA period, required modifications to the phasor system have been identified and must be completed before filing an FCC Form 302 application with a method of moment proof.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station KTCK(AM) may continue to operate during daytime hours with a reduced power of 15 kW (and full power during nighttime hours). It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. RLH must notify the Commission when licensed

operation is restored after filing the FCC Form 302 application to obtain an updated license.² RLH must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on December 11, 2015.
