Dear Ms. Dortch:

This letter is on behalf of Dallas Broadcasting, LLC ("DBL"), the licensee of radio station KVCE(AM), Highland Park, Texas. By letter dated June 12, 2015, the Audio Division, Media Bureau, granted KVCE the above-referenced special temporary authority ("STA") to operate during daytime hours using its nighttime directional array. The STA was requested because KVCE's daytime antenna site had been flooded when a nearby dam was released in response to heavy rains in the area.

By letter of undersigned counsel dated June 15, 2015, DBL notified the Commission that the flooding at the KVCE daytime site had not been as severe as initially anticipated, and that the water had receded to a point at which the station was able to continue daytime operation from its licensed daytime site. Accordingly, DBL's June 15, 2015 letter advised the Commission that KVCE was operating pursuant to its license and the STA was no longer necessary.

Since the June 15, 2015 letter, however, DBL has been notified that the nearby dam will be released once again as a result of additional heavy rains in the area, and that this time the water level will almost certainly be sufficient to submerge the KVCE daytime site. Accordingly, this is to advise the Commission that, notwithstanding its June 15, 2015 letter, it will indeed be necessary for KVCE to operate under the above-referenced STA. DBL requests that the Commission maintain the STA in effect.
