This is in reference to the request filed on February 12, 2015. DBC requests further extension of the STA originally granted on March 30, 2010, to operate with parameters at variance from licensed values and/or reduced power while maintaining monitor points within licensed limits due to replacement of a co-located FM antenna. In support of the request, DBC requests additional time to operate on STA until after final Commission action on the related application BZ-20150105ABQ, filed to update all operating parameters.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station WDEL may continue to operate with parameters at variance from licensed values and/or reduced power while maintaining monitor points within licensed limits. It will be necessary to further reduce

power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. DBC must notify the Commission when licensed operation is restored.² DBC must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on September 9, 2015.
