Dear Licensee:

This is in reference to the request filed June 30, 2015, on behalf of Public Broadcasting of Colorado, Inc. (PBC). PBC requests further extension of the special temporary authority (STA) originally granted on April 21, 1999, to operate Station KCFR-FM (formerly KVOD) with reduced power and a modified antenna.¹ By operating in this manner, KCFR-FM mitigates RF hotspots at the transmitter site on Lookout Mountain.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Our review indicates that the licensee has been prevented from restoring licensed operation due to causes beyond its control and has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

¹ See BLSTA-19990126W7, in which KCFR (FM) was operating at 85% of licensed ERP.

Thus, extension of STA is warranted.

In view of the above, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station KCFR-FM may continue to operate with reduced power and with a modified antenna, pending resolution of the RFR issues. PBC must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from radiofrequency exposure in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on January 5, 2016.
