Dear Mr. Bingham:

This is in reference to the above-captioned license application for KHIT. This application was originally filed to cover construction permit BPH-10054, as last modified by BMPH-821206AE.

A telegram was sent from the FM Branch dated January 15, 1985 notifying KHIT of discrepancies in coordinates and tower height between the construction permit BMPH-821206AE and the above license application. KHIT responded as requested by submitting a corrective Form 301 for construction permit on October 26, 1984. However, this application was never assigned a file number due to the lack of Sections I and VII from the application.

On October 2, 1984, KHIT filed an application proposing the same facilities as filed in the October 26, 1984 submission, with the exception of the effective radiated power being increased from 30 kW to 100 kW. This application, assigned the file number BPH-841002AY, was granted on January 18, 1985. A covering license application was filed on May 3, 1985 to cover this permit, and was recently found acceptable and granted.

Since KHIT has a license to cover its operation, further processing on license application BLH-840411BZ is unnecessary. Consequently, this license application is hereby DISMISSED, as the underlying construction permit BPH-10054 (as modified by BMPH-821206AE) is superceded by BPH-841002AY. This action does not imply any judgment that the authority for KHIT to conduct program tests operation after the filing of BLH-840411BZ was invalid. It is noted that the license application was timely filed pursuant to the April 11, 1984 Commission telegram (which permitted the license to be filed up to April 15, 1984) in compliance with Section 73.1620.

One copy of the license application will be retained for reference, this action being taken pursuant to Section 0.283 of the Commission's Rules.
