## Dear Former Licensee:

On April 26, 2007, the Video Division, Media Bureau ("Division") issued a Notice of Apparent Liability for Forfeiture<sup>1</sup> to ACME Television Licenses of Illinois, LLC, former licensee of Station WBUI(TV), for failure to failure to comply with the limits on commercial matter in children's programming.<sup>2</sup> This letter is to inform you that the Division does not plan to take further action relating to this matter and considers this proceeding closed. You should not construe the closing of the proceeding as a determination that a violation did not occur. The Division will not hesitate to take action against the Licensee for violations, including those of a similar nature, that occur in the future.
