Dear Licensee:

This is in reference to the request filed August 20, 2015, on behalf of Community Wireless of Park City, Inc. ("CWPC"). CWPC explains that KPCW continues to operate at reduced power of 150 watts ERP due to difficulty with one antenna bay, which has been removed. CWPC requests an extension of the February 18, 2015 Special Temporary Authority (STA) to allow continued operations at reduced power until repairs can be completed.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

It is not apparent from this STA extension request that the licensee has made any progress toward restoring licensed operation. Indeed, this extension requests merely parrots the language filed in the original STA request. We will grant the requested extension, but advise CWPC that it will need to summarize its efforts during the past STA period in any future extension requests.

Accordingly, the request for STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station KPCW may continue to operate with reduced power. CWPC must notify the Commission when licensed operation is restored. CWPC must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from radiofrequency exposure in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310. CWPC must notify the Commission once licensed operations resumes.

This authority expires on February 22, 2016.
