## REPLY TO OPPOSITION TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION

The Board of Trustees of Eastern Mennonite University, licensee of WEMC, Harrisonburg, Virginia ("WEMC"), respectfully submits this reply to the Opposition to Petition for Reconsideration submitted by Stu-Comm, Inc. ("Stu-Comm").

Stu-Comm states that the petition filed by WEMC is lacking in both signature and address.

The <u>original</u> copy of the *Petition for Reconsideration* submitted to the Commission was signed by Twila King Yoder on October 7, 2009. The cover letter attached to the petition, and received by **Stu-Comm**, plainly stated the address for all correspondence to the signatory.

The **opposition** states that they have "significant concerns about whether this filing was truly authorized by the Board of Trustees of Eastern Mennonite University."

Twila King Yoder, an employee of Eastern Mennonite University is the Corporate Secretary to the Board and as such is authorized to sign on behalf of the Board.

WEMC has made a strong case in the issue of negligible population in other pleadings against Virginia Tech Foundation and noted that the parent station cited in this "fill-in" application prepared by the same consulting engineer is also licensed by Virginia Tech Foundation. This is the reason for our petition.

WEMC has no interest in attempting to "delay, obfuscate or harass Stu-Comm in its operation," rather WEMC desires that our petition be considered on its merits thereby creating a level-playing field
