NCE Station KNWP(FM), Port Angeles, Washington (Facility ID 81161)

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of Washington State University ("WSU"), licensee of noncommercial educational radio station KNWP(FM), Port Angeles, Washington, we hereby inform the Commission that KNWP has resumed full power, licensed operation following a period of reduced power operation.

Washington State University previously notified the Commission in FCC File No. BSTA-20150129AFA of KNWP's temporary reduced power status due to equipment problems, and requested Special Temporary Authority ("STA") for the reduced power operation to continue for more than 30 days. The Commission granted reduced power STA for KNWP on February 6, 2015, and an extension on August 5, 2015 in FCC File No. BESTA-20150717AAL. The licensee now notifies the Commission that KNWP has resumed full power, licensed operation.

Washington State University is a noncommercial educational licensee and operates KNWP on a noncommercial educational basis. Moreover, the licensee qualifies as a governmental entity. The licensee is therefore exempt from FCC filing fee and regulatory fee requirements for KNWP, pursuant to Sections 1.1116 and 1.1162 of the Commission's rules.
