This is in reference to the request filed on August 31, 2015. TMDL requests an extension of the STA granted on March 11, 2015, to operate station WEBC(AM) with parameters at variance from license values and/or reduced power while maintaining monitor points within license limits due to malfunctioning sample lines.<sup>1</sup> In support of the request, TMDL states that it has verified that the sample lines are defective in the past six month STA period, and is examining options for repairing or replacing the sample lines.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

After the sample lines have been replaced (or repaired), TMDL will need to file an FCC Form 302 application to make any necessary changes to the operating parameters before the expiration date shown below. Otherwise TMDL must file a one page letter in triplicate with the Office of the Secretary to the attention of supervisory engineer Son Nguyen to notify the Commission when licensed



operations have been restored. The letter should also include a request to electronically reissue the most recent license to correct any known errors, and to certify no changes to the operating parameters are needed (along with a copy of the most recent license for reference purposes).

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station WEBC(AM) may continue to operate with parameters at variance from license values and/or reduced power while maintaining MPs within licensed limits. It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. TMDL must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **March 23, 2016**.
