That was confirmed when I heard the station on the air as "La Raza" a Mexican station. Many years ago Nicolas came to me and said that he wanted to buy an AM station and that he wanted me to be his partner. The station was KXOL 1660 AM. He got the station and never made me a partner. He would not return my calls and for years I did not speak to him. I decided I had to take him to court. I also found out that he lost the station because he does not manage very well.

Nicolas needs to repay the people he has ruined. He took all of my life savings. With this letter I have included a copy of the case number for the courts. Civil No. 090903979. The judge awarded me \$210,000, but Nicolas cannot be found. There are many other people that he has done this to. I have spoken to some of them and they will be sending letters to you also. Please help me to regain my life.


