## Dear Licensee:

The Video Division ("Division") issued an Order to Show Cause on July 30, 2015, calling upon Kingdom Broadcasting Inc. ("Licensee"), to show cause why its authorization for Class A television station KMLB-LP, El Dorado, Arkansas ("Station") should not have its class of service modified reclassified to low power television. The Order to Show Cause found that the Licensee failed to establish an electronic public file through the Commission-hosted website or upload to its electronic public file required information/documents, as required by Commission rules.<sup>2</sup>

On August 27, 2015, the Licensee filed a timely response to the Order to Show Cause. It has come to the attention of the Division that due to a technical issue with the Commission-hosted website the Station's electronic public file was not able to be accessed by staff at the time the Order to Show Cause was issued. The technical issue preventing the Station's electronic public file from being viewed has now been addressed and upon review of the Station's electronic public file and documentation included with the Licensee's response we hereby **RESCIND** the Order to Show Cause.

We also find, in accordance with Section 309(k) of the Act,<sup>3</sup> that **GRANT** of the Station's license renewal application is in the public interest.
